TIME LIMIT

No new inning shall begin after two hours have elapsed from the first pitch unless the game is tied. Exception: Championship Games are extended to no new inning after 2:15 from first pitch.

All games shall be considered complete and official when time curfew is reached unless the game is tied at the end of the last complete inning. In that case:

- (1) If the game is part of pool play, the game shall end in a tie.
- (2) If the game is not part of pool play, the game shall be allowed to continue w/o curfew until a winner is decided.

All extra innings play and any post-curfew play due to a tied score shall follow the international tie-breaker rule, explained elsewhere.

Championship Game – No new inning after 2:15 from first pitch is in effect. Also, if score is tied at the end of regulation, or when the curfew is reached, the international tie-breaking rule shall be used. Play will proceed until there is a winner.
