

# LAST MAN STANDING TOURNAMENTS

Player Baseball Age = May 1<sup>st</sup> cutoff.

## PLAYER ELIGIBILITY RULES

Last Man Standing is an OPEN tournament, that means:

1. Non-ENYTB teams are welcome to register
2. ENYTB teams can add players to their tournament roster that were not on their regular season roster, with some limitations.

Roster MAX = 18 players at 16U and younger. 21 at 17U – 19U.

Over-aged Players (see below for pitching restrictions)

A - ENYTB Member Teams – Can only use over-aged players from their regular season roster.

B – Non-ENYTB Teams – Will be reviewed on case-by-case basis, but very limited circumstances allowed.

Player can only appear on one tournament roster per age level.  
Player can appear on tournament rosters for different teams at different tournament age levels (i.e. a 13/14U division & a 15/16U division)

Pitching Restrictions:

- Best In Class Divisions: All players on roster are eligible to pitch unless they violate age limits (see below)
- AAA and AA Divisions: ENYTB teams can only declare one of their bonus players (non-regular season roster player, added for tournament only) as “Pitcher Eligible”. This must be denoted on the online tournament roster.

## Pitching Restrictions – Over-Aged Players

NOTE: 13U – 18U is **DIFFERENT RULES** than regular season

- 9/10U Division – Players that are baseball age 11 cannot pitch;
- 11/12U Division – Players that are baseball age 13 cannot pitch;
- 13/14U Division - pitchers who are baseball age 15 are allowed to pitch against teams that are 13+, 14, and 14+. They are NOT allowed to pitch against a pure 13U team.
- 15/16U Division - pitchers who are baseball age 17 are allowed to pitch against teams that are 15+, 16, and 16+. They are NOT allowed to pitch against a pure 15U team.
- 17/19U Division – ALL players are eligible to pitch in all games.

7 – A player may participate in more than one age division of either tournament:

A – In the event of any conflicts between the player's primary and secondary teams, player must give priority to his primary team;

and,

B – Player can NOT be used to pitch or catch by his secondary team w/o first obtaining written/signed permission for such use from his primary team.

## 8 - Player Eligibility Challenges

Any objections to the eligibility of a player on another team's LMS tournament roster must be made no later than the Monday before the start of the first scheduled game of the tournament.
