Battle By Saratoga – Rain/Weather Policy

The Tournament Director reserves the right to change the tournament schedule as needed due to weather.

Every division of the tournament has teams that have traveled from out of state to participate. Significant weather delays will increase the need for flexibility to complete the tournament by Monday afternoon.

If needed, the Tournament Director reserves the right to:

1. Change start time and/or location of a game(s).
2. Change the format of the tournament.
3. Shorten the length of each game (i.e. 5 inning games).
4. Increase the number of games a team plays in a day.

These measures will be reserved as an absolute last resort. But, unlike local tournaments, the games cannot be delayed in perpetuity.

Any format change that reduces the number of games a team participates in will be subject to the standard Refund Policy of the tournament (see separate document).

Any tournament game that gets called for weather by the umpires shall be considered an official game if:

1. Three full innings have been completed at 10U – 12U
2. Four full innings have been completed at 13U & 14U
