

EXTRA INNINGS - INTERNATIONAL TIE-BREAKER RULE ADOPTED

To help keep the LMS tournaments on schedule, ENYTB has adopted the International Tie Breaker rule all extra inning games.

What is the International Tie Breaker rule?

When a regulation game ends in a tie, the International Tie Breaker rule is used.

(1) At the beginning of each team's at-bat in the first extra inning, the last batter from the previous inning is placed on 2nd base.

(2) At the beginning of each team's at-bat in the 2nd extra inning or later, the last batter from the previous inning is placed on 2nd base and the next to last batter is placed on 3B.

NOTE: It is not sudden death. Each team has an opportunity to bat in each inning. The game ends when one team is ahead at the end of an inning.
