

EXTRA INNINGS - INTERNATIONAL TIE-BREAKER RULE ADOPTED

The International Tie Breaker rule goes into effect when a game is tied at the end of regulation.

The International Tie Breaker rule also goes into effect if the time limit is reached, and the game is tied. The first inning of post-curfew play will follow the International Tie Breaker, even if it is the 7th inning or earlier.

INTERNATIONAL TIEBREAKER PROTOCOL:

(1) At the beginning of each team's at-bat in the first extra inning (or post curfew play), the last batter from the previous inning is placed on 2nd base.

(2) At the beginning of each team's at-bat in the 2nd extra inning or later, the last batter from the previous inning is placed on 2nd base and the next to last batter is placed on 3B.

NOTE: It is not sudden death. Each team has an opportunity to bat in each inning. The game ends when one team is ahead at the end of a complete inning.
