SPECIAL TOURNAMENT RAIN RULES

- (1) All play stands if game is stopped due to weather before game is of official length. In other words, games will be treated as SUSPENDED games (not rainouts) if they are started but fail to reach official length before they are called.
- (2) OFFICIAL LENGTH Is redefined for tournament play to 4 innings OR 90 minutes of play if the game is stopped due to bad weather. Thus, if the trailing team has had four complete innings of at-bats, and the game is called for bad weather, the game is official and counts as a complete game. Or, if 90 minutes has elapsed since the official first pitch, the game is official and counts as a complete game.
