

2:00 TIME LIMIT

No new inning shall begin after two hours have elapsed from the first pitch unless the game is tied. Exception = Championship game has a time limit of no new inning after 2:15.

All games shall be considered complete and official when time curfew is reached unless the game is tied at the end of the last complete inning. In that case:

- (1) If the game is part of pool play, the game shall end in a tie.
- (2) If the game is not part of pool play, the game shall be allowed to continue w/o curfew until a winner is decided.

All extra innings play and any post-curfew play due to a tied score shall follow the international tie-breaker rule, explained elsewhere.

Championship Game Extension – Time Limit of no new inning after 2:15 from first pitch is in effect. Also, if score is tied at the end of regulation, or when the curfew is reached, the international tie-breaking rule shall be used. Play will proceed until there is a winner.

In the event of weather or injury delay(s)... the game clock will pause for a maximum of 20 minutes during any one game.
