

FORMAT – The weekend is a two-game guarantee. This is accomplished by creating multiple competitive divisions of the tournament. Depending on the number of entries, there can be up to 3 tournament divisions per age group: Super 8, Madness, and Last Chance.

1. Top 8 teams from each age group start in Super 8. Round 1 losers “drop down” to Madness bracket.
2. Remaining teams, if any, begin in the Madness bracket. Round 1 loses in the Madness bracket “drop down” to a Last Chance bracket.

NOTE: For larger fields, the early rounds may be treated as play-in rounds where the lower seeds are paired against each other while the higher seeds sit.

SEEDING - A team’s seeding shall be based on its position in the SUPER 8 or MADNESS standings for its age division. If an outlier situation exists (i.e. a team has very few games played), the tournament director can exercise discretion when determining seeding.
