TIME LIMIT APPLICABLE TO ALL TOURNAMENT GAMES

6 INNING GAMES = NO NEW INNING CAN BEGIN 1:50 AFTER FIRST PITCH
7 INNING GAMES = NO NEW INNING CAN BEGIN 1:50 AFTER FIRST PITCH

The time of first pitch should be announced and agreed upon between coaches and umpires at the pre-game conference.

The start of a new inning is marked as the moment the third out is recorded in the bottom of the previous inning.

For example, if the third out of the bottom of the 6th inning is made at 1:49 after first pitch, the 7th inning SHALL be played.

All games shall be considered complete and official when time curfew is reached unless the game is tied at the end of the last complete inning. In that case, the game shall be allowed to continue w/o curfew until a winner is decided.

All extra innings play and any post-curfew play due to a tied score shall follow the international tie-breaker rule, explained elsewhere.

Championship Game – Curfew shall remain in effect. Also, if score is tied at the end of regulation, or when the curfew is reached, the international tiebreaking rule shall be used. Play will proceed until there is a winner.
