

EXTRA INNINGS - INTERNATIONAL TIE-BREAKER RULE ADOPTED

What is the International Tie Breaker rule?

The International Tie Breaker rule goes into effect when a game (full game based on number of innings) is tied at the end of regulation.

It also goes into effect if the Time Limit is reached, and the score is tied. The first inning to begin after the time limit must follow these rules:

(1) At the beginning of each team's at-bat in the first extra inning, the last batter from the previous inning is placed on 2nd base.

(2) At the beginning of each team's at-bat in the 2nd extra inning or later, the last batter from the previous inning is placed on 2nd base and the next to last batter is placed on 3B.

NOTE: It is not sudden death. Each team has an opportunity to bat in each inning. The game ends when one team is ahead at the end of a complete inning.

To help keep the tournament on schedule, ENYTB has adopted the International Tie Breaker rule for all extra-inning games, including the championship game, except as next noted.
